Completion of <u>EPSY 8960</u> Innovation, Technology and Teaching in Higher Education (3 s.h.) and HRPR 8985 <u>Teaching in Higher Education</u>: <u>Health Professions (3 s.h.)</u> earn the student the 6-credit graduate certificate in Teaching in Higher Education, which prepares graduates of the D.N.P. program to teach at the college level.

For post-master's DNP students, a total of 1,000 clinical hours is required to complete the degree. Of that total, 500 hours are divided across three courses as shown. Evaluation and verification of 500 hours earned during the student's completed master's program is required prior to formal admission to the program.
