Student Outcome Measures

Program Completion Rate: Students who enter the MA program in Speech Language Hearing Science with an Undergraduate degree in Communication Sciences & Disorders should complete the degree within 2 years across 6 semesters (Fall-Spring- Summer). Students who are admitted to the MA- SLH program with baccalaureate degrees in other areas must spend 1 year (Fall- Spring) taking Undergraduate pre-requisite courses and then typically complete graduate coursework over the usual 2 years, 6 semesters (Summer-Fall- Spring or the following Fall-Spring-Summer at their choosing) requiring 8 semesters. The following table contains data concerning students who complete the degree program within the specified time frame of the program.
