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### A. RESEARCH BIO

Dr. Krista Schroeder is a nurse scientist whose research examines how social determinants of health influence obesity risk, with a particular focus on the effect of adverse childhood experiences. Much of her work has taken a multi-level approach to understanding complex obesity risk factors and focused on engaging with populations most at risk for health disparities. Her methodological expertise includes large dataset analysis, geospatial research for examining neighborhood effects on health, and quantitative and statistical approaches for program and policy evaluation. Her present research, funded by a NIH K23 Career Development Award, examines the association between neighborhood environment, adverse childhood experiences, and childhood obesity.
